What is Camp Ladybug?

Camp Ladybug is a camp for individuals who are medically diagnosed with having mental and/or physical challenges. Our purpose is to provide a fun atmosphere where the campers may participate in socialization skills and recreational activities.

When and where is Camp Ladybug?

Camp Ladybug is scheduled for June 15-July 24, 2020 from 9 am-12 noon (Monday-Friday) at the Elizabethtown Park Pavilion #5 (located directly behind the Elizabethtown Mennonite Church parking lot).

When should I arrive and leave Camp Ladybug?

Please arrive by 8:45 a.m. and plan on staying until about 12:15 p.m. Since the camp is outside, part of the volunteer experience includes setting up and taking down each day's activities, so please come a few minutes early and stay a few minutes late.

Do I really have to attend the Orientation meeting?

Yes! Whether you are volunteering for your first time or you return every year it is important that you attend the orientation meeting. A lot of important information will be shared at the meeting including introductions, an overview of summer theme/activities, a list of special events, discussion of the expectations of volunteers, and a question & answer time. Please plan to be at the Orientation (**June 11th @ 12 noon.**)

How can I get a Camp Ladybug t-shirt?

Volunteers WILL BE getting t-shirts this year! We ask that you only provide a size for your t-shirt on the attached form if you plan on volunteering at camp for more than just one week.

What happens if it rains?

In the event of excessive rain, Camp Ladybug may be relocated to the Elizabethtown Mennonite Church (300 S. Spruce Street). If the camp is relocated, there will be an "inclement weather" message on GEARS phone system. Please call GEARS at 367-0355 to find out whether or not camp has been moved. We will also do our best to place a sign at the park site

What should I bring for snack?

Providing a snack is optional, but is very much appreciated by campers and other volunteers. Once you sign up for a specific date, please plan on providing snack for about 70 people. Want ideas? Consider bringing popcorn, pretzels, cheese puffs, animal crackers, cookies, goldfish, or homemade crispy treats, cookies, or brownies. Drinks aren't necessary. **Due to allergies, please refrain from bringing snacks with nuts.**

What happens if I can't show up to volunteer?

Please attend camp on all of the dates you've signed up for because we're counting on you and so are the campers. Camp Ladybug needs special volunteers like you to make it a success! If you absolutely cannot attend a date that you have signed up for please call 367-0355.

What if I don't have a ride to/from Camp Ladybug?

Please be sure to arrange for transportation to and from Camp Ladybug prior to attending camp each day because GEARS is unable to provide transportation for volunteers and/or campers.
